Our scientists will begin to learn about plants; exploring how they differ, naming common plants and why they need water.

Seasonal changes: Naming the 4 seasons, looking closely at the changes in trees. What skills are needed to be a weather reporter!





As musicians. we will be using instruments representing

animals, copying rhythms, learning a traditional Ghanaian call and response song and recognising simple notation.

In RSHE, children will learn about families, relationships, learning how families can differ and how we show our emotions to others.



Our explorers will ask the question 'What is it like here?'. They will use aerial photos to locate the school and where they live. Skills will include identifying features, creating and using maps of the school grounds and following routes.

Fieldwork will focus on improvements to the school playground. Enjoying books will be a priority throughout our day.. Our writing roots
