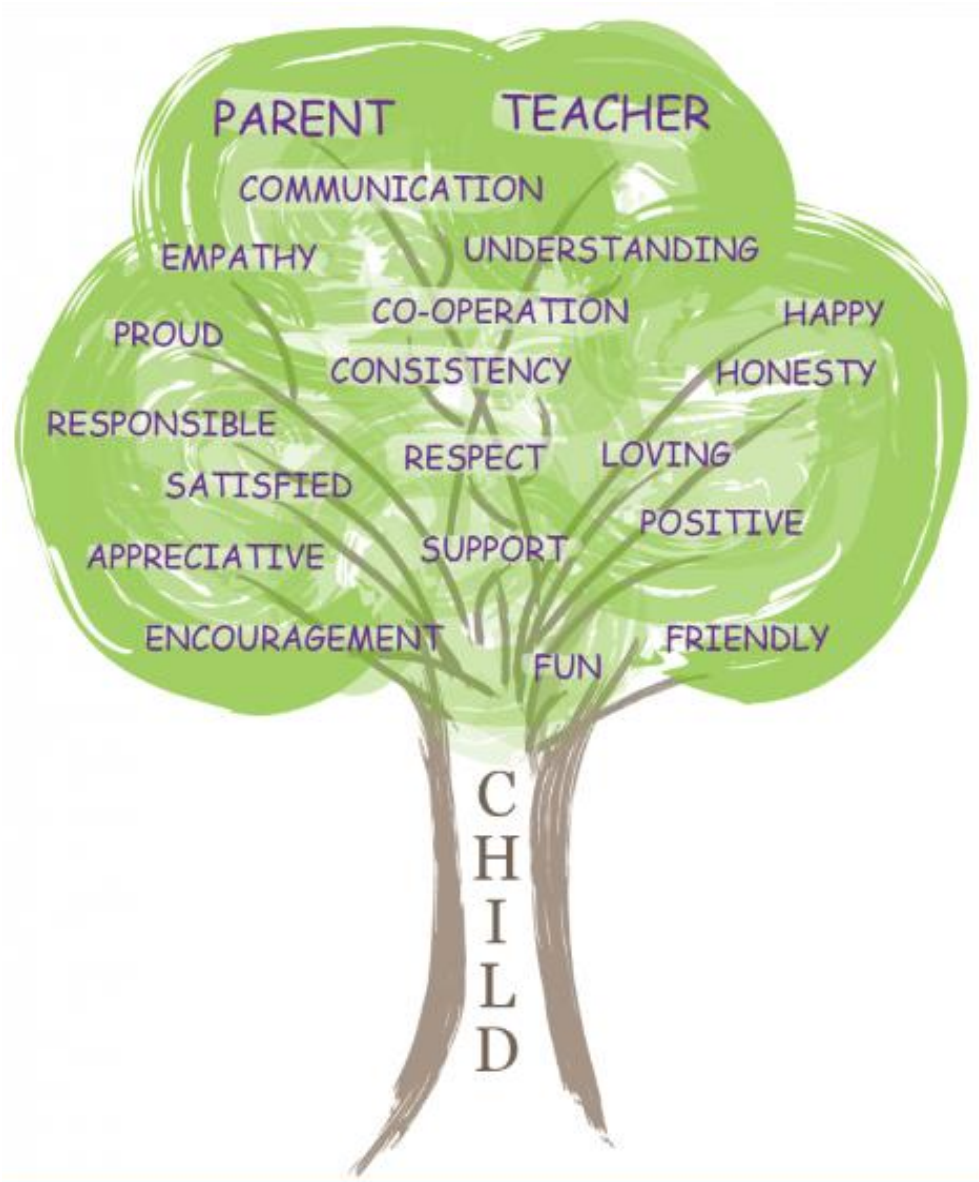
# Bitterns curriculum enhancements
