Summary table of responsibilities for school attendance

Statutory guidance for maintained schools, academies, independent schools, and local authorities

All pupils

Parents are expected to:

Notify the school as soon as possible when their child has to be unexpectedly absent (e.g. sickness).

Only request leave of absence in exceptional circumstances and do so in advance.

Book any medical appointments around the school day where possible.

A word on SATs - Statutory Assessment Tests

- Each May ,Year 6 children take part in SATs. They gain a mark which shows how they have achieved against the end of Key Stage 2 expectations.
- ► SATs week: week beginning Monday 12th May
- Externally marked tests:

English: Reading (1 hour)
Grammar and punctuation (45 minutes)
Spelling (20 minutes)
```

Maths: Paper 1 (Arithmetic - 30 minutes)
Paper 2 (Reasoning - 40 minutes)
Paper 3 (Reasoning - 40 minutes)

No calculators allowed in any test

Writing - teacher assessment of their writing throughout the year
