Children should read daily at home

Children who read at least four times in a week will be entered into the reading raffle

Daily phonics lessons in school

Handwriting - do encourage good pencil grip, it is much harder to correct an older child's incorrect pencil grip or letter formation

- remember nip, flip, grip then froggy legs

Year 1's - may sign up for sports club on a Thursday after school
