# aily reading

- Children should read daily at home
- Children who read at least four times in a week will be entered into the reading raffle
- Daily phonics lessons in school
- https://www.jollylearning.co.uk/resource-bank/learn-the-letter-sounds/ how to correctly say the sounds the continuous sounds (m, s,f,r,n,v) should be said without the 'schwa' or 'u'
- Handwriting do encourage good pencil grip, it is much harder to correct an older child's incorrect pencil grip or letter formation
  - remember nip, flip, grip then froggy legs
