Our scientists will develop their working scientifically skills, doing this whilst learning about



rocks, soils light and shadows. Key areas of learning will include palaeontology, soil formation and sources of light. Key vocabulary: fossils, crystal, sediment, shadow, luminous, transparent and opaque.

In RE, our theologists will discover and explore the big questions 'What is it like to follow God?' and 'How do people express commitment to a religion or worldview in different ways?'

In RSHE, our unit is 'Safety and the changing body'. This will learning about cyber bullying, email safety, effects on the



body from stings and bites and rules for road safety.

Our linguists will be learning French adjectives with focus on size, colours and shapes.



Our **explorers** will investigate and compare life in Antarctica. We will learn about explorer Shackleton and his journey to Antarctica. Key vocabulary: latitude, longitude and climate zones. *Geographical* 

skills: locational knowledge, place knowledge, human and physical geography and geographical skills and fieldwork.

In class, we will share books daily. Our writing roots from Literacy



Tree will be 'Escape from Pompeii' and 'The Black Dog'. Our class reading book will be 'Earth shattering events'. These high-quality books alongside books from our reading spine

will be the focus of our English lessons including writing, genres and grammar, punctuation and spelling.



Our big question we will explore during the spring term:

## Who lives in Antarctica?



Our musicians will focus on singing techniques.

Kingfishers will have a theme 'Vikings' using sight and ear to recognise rhythmic notation. Our new vocab will include crotchet, quaver,

call and response.

In **PE**, our units will be gymnastics, dance and outdoor adventurous activities. We will continue to plan, apply and assess using GetSet4PE.

Our historians will be investigating the big question: Why did the Romans invade and settle in Britain? We will be using evidence and artefacts to chronologically and accurately answer our question. Key vocabulary: archelogy, conquer, emperor, legacy and settlement.



Our **designers** will focus on the properties of Pneumatic toys. As



artists, we will be continuing our historical prior knowledge by

creating prehistoric paintings.

In Computing, children will develop their skills and knowledge in using Microsoft 365 email. This will link to our RSHE of email safety.

Our **English** and **Maths** long-term plans are on the curriculum page of our website. We use Literacy Tree and White Rose Maths.
